

**TOWN OF SHARPSBURG
MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**

March 21, 2011

A regular meeting of the Sharpsburg Town Council was held Monday, March 21, 2011, at 7:00pm, in the Town of Sharpsburg at the Bridges Recreation Center.
