1. Sharpsburg Library – Council Member Teagle gave an update to the work done. No action, no vote
 - a. Progress in January – Council Member Teagle gave an update to the work done with on cataloging 400 books into the Hoopla application.
 - b. Formation of Library Committee – Discussion between Mayor, Council Members, and Town Attorney regarding forming such a committee. No vote, no action.

Public Comments: In regard to the sidewalk discussion below, April Yarbrough added that there are Grants available. The Town could hire a firm that headhunts for such grants.

Polling of Council: Council Member Puckett-Pike gave her opinion that it would be nice to have sidewalks within the Town. Making it easier for all to use and enjoy. Mayor Good expressed that it would be a good idea to and will look into it further. Council Member Edge spoke of sidewalks using LMIG and ARPA monies for such a project, along with striping of roads. Council Member Teagle added

that Main Street and Terrentine Road would be a good starting point for sidewalks. Doing project in pieces as money becomes available.

Administrator's Report: Was read by Mayor Good for Town Administrator Jones who was not present at the meeting. Topics covered were the library, anticipated funding for the demolition of 39 Main Street house, quotes for striping of streets, security cameras. LMIG grant for 2024 was approved. The Christmas tree needs to be removed. The Town's Annual Audit will take place in the first week of March.
